What is the meaning of accessibility

- Accessibility concerns in how to make the website accessible for all users everywhere.
- It's how to make the website available for everyone whatever the machine or software they are using for browsing your site.

For whom the accessibility rules is used

- The website must be accessible for all, but there is some cases that needs to be handled in other ways.
- For example we have users that can not see, hear or even read or type.



For whom the accessibility rules is used

- And there are users that have slow Internet connection.
- Others can not use their hands for the moment and users with different browsers.



For whom the accessibility rules is used

- All of them must be able to use your website.

How to make a website accessible for all

- There are some rules and standards to make any website accessible for any user.
- Rules depending on what kind of user is using the site and countries.

How to make a website accessible for all

- For people who have less abilities than us we should always:
 - 1) Make sure that the font colors are clear and fit with the backgrounds used.
example not good
 - 2) Try to use small letters and never to use UPPERCASE letters to get attention.
 - 3) Make sure that all the elements are accessible by keyboard using tab or arrows.

How to make a website accessible for all

- 4) Always use alt texts for the images.
- 5) Put a navigation links at the beginning and the end of the page that refers to some contents in side the same page and some main links in the site.
- 6) Do not use display none CSS property, but why?
